For students aged 5-7 years old we take the Early Years Pedagogy into Key stage 1 (KS1), which is the primary curriculum in the United Kingdom. Our students still have opportunities to learn and explore the areas of the classroom such as the sand tray, role-play area etc. just like in the Early Years program. In addition to this they will be introduced to additional KS1 subjects such as history, geography, science and information and computer technologies (ICT).


- ☆ **English language lessons** held in a group or individually;

- ☆ **Football** - students learn key football skills through play;
- ☆ **Saturday Club** – Every Saturday from 10AM - 2PM a new topic is taught by our British teachers in accordance with the British EYFS curriculum.
